



## LYNX Enterprise 5.2.1.3 – What's New

- Implements a “Quick Add” feature. This feature allows an administrator to create/edit a template project with common data and search fields. A user with “Project Add” rights can use the “Quick Add” feature to create a new project, or when filing photos in a roll panel. If the user selects “Quick Add”, a window is provided prompting for a project name. After entering the new project name and clicking OK, the new project is added with the data, search fields, and keywords from the template project. The new project is added to the user’s assigned projects and to the assigned projects in all groups where the user is a member.
- Added the ability to group edit captions and notes in a browser panel. The user can now select multiple thumbnails and group edit these fields using the “Edit” menu or the context menu when right clicking on one of the selected thumbnails.
- Added an “Options Menu” item for “Photo Delete”. With this option a user can select to “enable/disable” the Recycle Bin and choose whether to confirm when permanently deleting photos. If the Recycle Bin is “disabled” and “Confirm on Delete” is unchecked, then deleting photos results in permanently deleting the photos with no warning.
- Added the version number in the title of the main page.
- Added a vertical scroll bar to the Notes section in the Photo Info tab.
- Changed the “Options\Labels” menu so that only administrators can change labels.
- When opening a roll panel we now show a new form which allows the user to select “View without filing, File to an existing project, or Quick Add”. This replaces the “Do you intend to file some or all of these photos” message box.
- Changed the methods used for group annotating in roll panels. This corrected some issues with filing photos and group annotation. These changes eliminated the “Save Changes” button on the main form.
- Added the “Original Date Taken” and “Original Date Modified” values to the photo details.
- Added the ability to search projects for “Source”. This allows the user to search for photos by the original source (license SN).
- Changed the Project Edit Form to allow an administrator to set all labels to user defined values. Note these are global values, and all users will see the labels defined by the administrator.



## LYNX Enterprise 5.2.1.3 – What's New

- Changed the Project Edit Form to have all fields in the “Contact Data” tab to be combo boxes instead of text boxes. The combo boxes will be automatically loaded with available data. They are all the same size with a maximum of 50 characters per field.
- Changed the Project Edit Form to remove the “Save Changes” button. Clicking OK will automatically save any changes.
- Changed the Edit Search Fields form to allow administrators, or users with “Project Edit” rights to add, edit, or delete Search Field labels. Also added the ability for users to add, edit, or delete Search Field values.
- Changed the browser form so that clicking on any part of the label is the same as clicking on the thumbnail. Previously a user had to click on the thumbnail to select a photo.
- Changed the password for the LynxDBUser to be a strong password.
- Changed SelectForm so that double clicking on an item is the same as clicking on an item and then hitting OK
- Added “Display By” in the projects tab so the user can show projects by name, number, or description.
- Changed the Project Edit Search field tab so the user can now specify if a search field is alpha-numeric, numeric, or date data types. Now you can specify a search field as numeric, for example, and you will get correct results in a search.
- Changed the Search field edit form so that the search field label automatically drops to the next search field after the user assigns a search field value to the photo.
- Changed the search field edit form so the data value is automatically selected if it has already been assigned to the photo. If no value is assigned, the first data value is selected. This allows a user to just start typing and the list drops to the data value being typed.
- Added the Roll Photo Number in a roll panel when the user clicks on a thumbnail. The Roll Photo Number is displayed in the status bar on the panel.
- Eliminated the “Select a Project” dialog when the user is editing or deleting a project if there is only one project displayed. This dialog is also eliminated if the user selects “File to an existing project” when filing photos if there is only one project displayed.



## LYNX Enterprise 5.2.1.3 – What's New

- Changed the installer so that the user now has three options when installing:
  - Network or standalone (default)
  - Database and license files only (no application files installed)
  - Workstation
- Changed the installer so that the user only points to the shared LynxCommonFiles folder when installing as a workstation. For example, you now enter [\\lynx\lynxcommonfiles](#) instead of [\\lynx\lynxcommonfiles\enterprise](#). If you use a mapped drive, you now map to the LynxCommonFiles folder.
- Added ReadMe.txt files to the installers that give the user some information for getting started. This includes default user name and password.
- Check for updates feature under Help Menu. This feature will go to our ftp site and get a list of all application files with their version number and date modified. It will compare the list with the user's application files and the database version. If updates are available, the user will be prompted to download the latest versions.
