



LYNX Enterprise 5.2.2.2 – What's New

- Added a field to a Project to specify the project as “Active”. “Active” can be turned on or off in the Project Edit screen. The default value for “Active” is true. NOTE: the user must be an administrator or have “Project Edit” rights to edit a project.
- Added radio buttons at the bottom of the Projects tab to allow the user to choose to view “Both active/inactive”, “Active only”, or “Inactive only” projects. The user can select the appropriate view option at any time. The user option is saved as a user preference when the application exits.
- Added “Allow photo compression” to the Options menu. This is a global option only visible to administrators. If an administrator “unchecks” this option, the Automatic compression feature is disabled when acquiring images. Users, including administrators, can only acquire images with the “Do not compress” feature until an administrator “checks” the “Allow photo compress” option again. NOTE: Global settings are read when the application first starts. If an administrator changes the “Allow photo compression” option, other users must restart the application before the change takes effect for them.
- Changed Lynx Client to allow “Check for updates...” in the Help menu.
- Removed the ability of administrators to delete items from the Photo Audit Trail.
- Added printing of the Photo Lab form to the application.
- Fixed a problem of printing multiple pages on the Photo Audit form.
- Users can no longer delete search field labels in the Search Field Edit form. Search fields can only be deleted using the Project Edit form by a user with administrative or “Project Edit” rights. In addition, users are now warned if they edit a search field label, edit a search field data value, or delete a search field data value. This is because editing (or deleting) this information affects all images in the project, not just the images they have selected when editing search fields.
- Added a test to determine read/write permissions for the license directory when the application starts.
- Added a menu item for “Use Passive Transfer on Update” in the Options menu. This menu item is only visible for administrators. Checking the item causes “Check for Updates” to use Passive mode for the ftp transfers. Unchecking the item uses Active mode for ftp transfers. This is a global setting, and affects all users.
- Users can now edit projects on Remote system types if they are administrators or have Project Edit rights.
